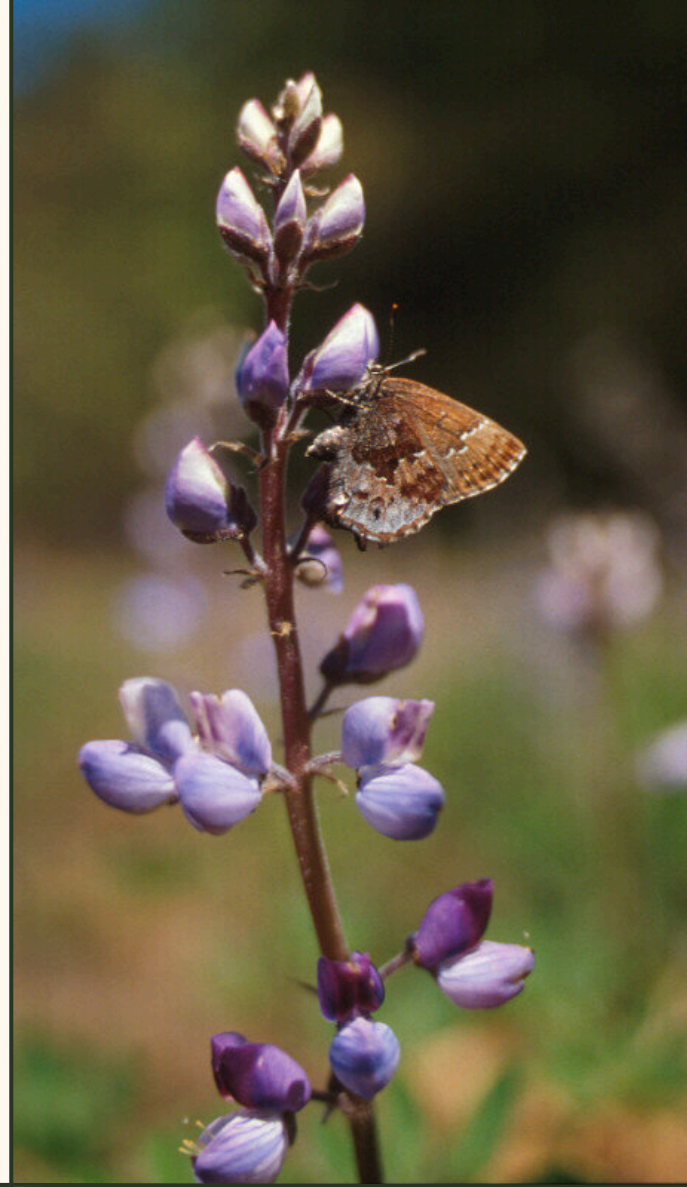


Seeking: Field Research Technicians for Butterfly Study
